Dul chun cinn i bpáirt Tá pleanáil á dhéanamh go leanúnach ag foireann na scoile. Ó am na meastóireachta scoile-uile tá dul chun cinn áirithe déanta maidir leis na sonraí a sholáthraítear sa phleanáil don difreáil agus don mheasúnú. I gcuid de na pleananna gearrthearmacha tá tagairt déanta do dhaltaí aonair maidir leis na straitéisí éagsúla don difreáil a chuirtear i bhfeidhm dóibh le linn na gceachtanna. I líon eile ranganna bíonn tagairt níos cineálaí déanta don difreáil iontu. I samplaí ar leith de phleananna reatha tá fíor-dhul chun cinn déanta le gníomhaíochtaí beachta, cuí do dhaltaí aonair ainmnithe, agus straiséisí measúnuithe beachta a bhain le hábhar na gceachtanna deartha sa phlean. Is úsáideach mar a dhéantar na sonraí seo a thaifeadh agus moltar an cleachtas seo a leathnú ar fud na scoile.
Chun tógáil ar an obair thairbheach atá déanta ar chlár cuimsitheach a dhearadh chun scileanna labhartha, léitheoireachta agus scríbhneoireachta a fhorbairt sa Ghaeilge, b'fhiú béim sa bhreis a leagan ar chumas na ndaltaí abairtí a struchtúrú. D'fhéadfaí é seo a chur chun cinn trí anailís a dhéanamh ar na botúin is coitianta a dhéanann siad.	Dul chun cinn an-mhaith Sna ceachtanna a breathnaíodh léirigh na daltaí go bhfuil siad an-ábailta agus ar a gcompord abairtí a struchtúrú i gceart, agus go cruinn ó thaobh na gramadaí de, le linn na cumarsáide. Is léir gur lean an fhoireann próiseas anailíse go héifeachtach mar a moladh. Sa teagasc tá cleachtais shaibhre sealbhaithe sa scoil a chuimsíonn múnlú cruinn na Gaeilge ag na hoidí, rud a chabhraíonn go mór le forbairt na teanga ghlacaí, úsáid áiseanna súl mar thacaíocht do dhaltaí chun na rialacha maidir le habairtí a struchtúrú go cruinn, agus plé substaintiúil rialta ar rialacha na teanga. Tá straitéisí féinmheasúnaithe sealbhaithe anois i measc na ndaltaí, rud a chuireann lena gcuid muiníne abairtí cuimsitheacha a chumadh agus a úsáid.

<p>The effectiveness of short-term planning would be improved if more specific reference to differentiation and assessment were included.</p>	<p>Partial progress</p> <p>The school staff engages in planning on a continuous basis. Since the whole-school evaluation, some progress has been made with regard to the detail provided in planning in respect of differentiation and assessment. In some of the short-term planning, reference is made to individual pupils with regard to the various differentiation strategies implemented for them during lessons. In a number of other lessons, more generic reference is made to differentiation. In particular examples of current planning, very good progress has been made, with specific activities appropriate to individual named pupils, and with particular assessment strategies linked to the subject of the lessons devised in the plan. The way in which these details are recorded is useful and this practice should be extended throughout the school.</p>
<p>In order to build on the beneficial work done in devising a comprehensive programme to develop spoken, reading and writing skills in Irish it would be worth further emphasising pupils' ability to structure sentences. This could be done through an analysis of the most frequent mistakes they make.</p>	<p>Very good progress</p> <p>In the lessons observed, pupils demonstrated that they are very capable and comfortable in the construction of correct and grammatically accurate sentences when communicating. Clearly, the staff has followed a process of analysis effectively, as was recommended. In teaching, the school has appropriated valuable practices, including teachers accurately modelling Irish, which greatly support the development of the receptive language, the use of visual aids to support pupils with the rules for structuring sentences accurately, and regular substantial discussion on the rules of the language. Grammar diaries are also being used effectively in the school. Pupils have now acquired strategies for</p>

	self-assessment which add to their confidence in composing and using comprehensive sentences.
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Summary of findings

The very good progress made by the school with regard to enabling the pupils to structure sentences accurately is commended, but there is more work to do regarding making reference to differentiation and assessment in planning.

Recommendations

- It would be worthwhile for the school to extend the good practice with regard to recording differentiation and assessment in the teachers' plans in a uniform way, on a whole-school basis.

The board of management was given an opportunity to comment in writing on the findings and recommendations of the report; a response was not received from the board.
