Moltar go mbeadh tuilleadh plé i measc na foirne ar litearthacht na Gaeilge agus go n-aontófaí straitéisí le cur i bhfeidhm chun feasacht na foirne agus na scoláirí ina leith a fhorbairt.	Dul chun cinn an-mhaith Léiríonn taifid scoile go ndéantar plé rialta i measc na foirne agus an bhoird bhainistíochta ar na straitéisí chun litearthacht na Gaeilge a chur chun cinn. Sna comhráit a bhí ag an gcigire le múinteoirí agus le scoláirí le linn na cigireachta leantaí ba léir go raibh an-chur amach acu ar na straitéisí céanna. Cuireadh go leor straitéisí i bhfeidhm ó foilsíodh an tuairisc MSU-BCF. Mar shampla, cláraíodh múinteoirí uile na scoile le ranganna.com ag tús na scoilbhliana 2016 agus d'fhreastail roinnt múinteoirí ar dhianchúrsa Gaeilge faoi scáth COGG. Tá na múinteoirí le moladh as ceachtanna gramadaí a chur ar fáil go rialta dá gcomhghleacaithe sa scoil féin. Maidir le cur chun cinn litearthacht na Gaeilge i measc na scoláirí, tá Coiste na Gaeilge an-ghníomhach sa scoil. Cuirtear béim rialta ar ghnéithe áirithe den ghramadach agus ar bhotúin chomónta, an t-alt agus inscne focal, mar shampla, i gceachtanna ar bhonn scoile uile. Cuirtear úrscéalta Gaeilge ar leabharliostaí na ranganna sóisearacha chun cur lena saibhreas Gaeilge. Cuirtear béim ar eochairfhocail agus saintearmaíocht i ngach ábhar. Eagraítear turais Ghaeltachta do scoláirí a chuidíonn lena bhfeasacht teanga agus chultúir. Bíonn comórtais ann don

Recommendation in original inspection report	Progress achieved to date on implementation of recommendation
<p>It is recommended that further discussion be carried out among the staff on Irish language literacy and that strategies for improvement be agreed to develop staff and student awareness of this.</p>	<p>Very good progress</p> <p>An examination of school records indicates that strategies to develop Irish language literacy are discussed regularly by staff and the board of management. In conversations which the inspector held with teachers and students during the follow-through inspection, it was evident that there was very good awareness and familiarity with these strategies. Many strategies for improvement have been implemented since the publication of the WSE-MLL report. For example, all teachers in the school registered with ranganna.com at the start of the 2016 school year and some teachers attended an intensive Irish course under the auspices of COGG. Members of staff are to be commended for providing grammar lessons regularly for their colleagues in the school.</p> <p>In relation to the development of Irish language literacy among students, there is a very active Irish Language Committee in the school. Regular emphasis is placed during lessons on particular aspects of grammar and common mistakes, the article and gender of words for example. Irish language novels are included on booklists for the junior classes to enrich students' linguistic competence. Lessons include an emphasis on key words and specialised terminology in every subject. Gaeltacht</p>

	excursions are organised for students to raise their awareness of language and culture. There is a competition for “An Gaeilgeoir is Fearr” in every class and the school was awarded the ‘Gaelbhrtach’ this year. The school is commended for regularly assessing and reviewing the progress made in regard to the implementation of the strategies.
It is recommended that school decisions in relation to school self-evaluation are implemented systematically on a whole-school basis	Good progress The results of a recent school survey demonstrated that the vast majority of teachers were implementing a great number of the school decisions in relation to literacy and that a smaller percentage were implementing the numeracy strategies. Some lessons and samples of students’ work were observed during this evaluation; it was evident that many of the strategies were being implemented effectively. There were other minor strategies, including an agreed system for correcting grammatical errors, which were still not being implemented widely. The senior management team agreed that there was still further progress to be made in this area on a whole-school basis.
It is recommended that further emphasis be placed on accurate written and oral sentence construction systematically throughout the school.	Very good progress The very good emphasis which was placed on practising accurate forms of speech and writing was noted in the lessons observed, in students’ copies and on the notice boards in classrooms. Students’ progress in this area of learning is regularly assessed.
Summary of findings	
Very good progress has been made to date in relation to the implementation of the main recommendations contained in the WSE-MLL report in 2014. There was a very good emphasis placed on Irish language literacy in the lessons observed as part of the follow-through inspection. The senior management team is doing its utmost and the teaching staff are responding well to that.	
Recommendations

The school community should consider reducing the number of strategies to be implemented annually and focus on implementing a smaller number of strategies incrementally every year.
