It is recommended that a more concise format be developed for monthly progress records.		<p><b>Very good progress</b></p> <p>A comprehensive review of the format of monthly progress records was undertaken by the staff. Teachers are now more conscious of the need to keep these records in a concise and accessible format. Additionally, at the end of each year, a concise document is passed from the current class teacher to the teacher who will take the class in the coming year.</p>

Tá saothair na ndaltaí sa Ghaeilge ar taispeáint sna dorchlaí chomh maith. Is mór is fiú é seo a dhéanamh mar tugann sé aitheantas do na daltaí as a gcuid oibre sa Ghaeilge. Tá lipéid ar taispeáint freisin sna dorchlaí chun tábhacht na Gaeilge a athneartú do na daltaí agus na tuismitheoirí araon agus chun foclóir agus frásaí a mhúineadh. <i>In every class, samples of pupils' work in Irish are displayed systematically. Pupils' work is also displayed in the corridors. This is well worth doing as it gives recognition to pupils for their work. Labels are also displayed in the corridors to emphasise the importance of Irish for pupils and parents alike and to teach Irish vocabulary and phrases.</i></p>
