



- 9. The data for 1993/94 and subsequent years exclude students aged 25 and over for percentage calculations.


NUMBER OF FULL-TIME STUDENTS BY LEVEL 1999/2000




PUPIL TEACHER RATIO

- 13. The figure shown for the Leaving Certificate excludes candidates who are participants in the Vocational Training Opportunities Scheme


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











EDUCATION EXPENDITURE PER PUPIL BY LEVEL (£s) 1999/2000






