Who can use the Framework?

The Potential Framework Clients are:

Irish primary, Lots 1-5; post-primary and special schools, groups and clusters of schools and Education and Training Boards, Lots 6-10.

Education and Training Boards, (ETBs), will utilise Lots 6-10 for all of their site requirements including further education colleges, multi-faith community national schools and a range of adult, further education and training centres.

How to use this Framework?

This is a direct drawdown framework agreement (FWA). Schools that have identified a need for services provided in this FWA should contact their chosen supplier and request further detail on the service provided along with a Notification to Activate Services Form ("NASF").

Following the execution of the NASF by both the school in question and the Framework Supplier, the Supplier will provide the Services to the Framework Client (the school) in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Call-off Contract.




Pricing




The price a school pays will be determined during negotiations with the supplier.

Each Framework Member has agreed a maximum ceiling price on a per capita (per student, per-annum) basis.
