I refer to the request which you made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for records held by this body:

"I would be obliged if you could forward to me a copy of the following statutory instrument SI80/20/10/1217 which adverts to regulations precluding Teachers and Lecturers from Institutes of Technology access to Job-Sharing arrangements while serving in the Oireachtas. This document is now more than 5 years old and as such I can see no reason why it cannot be released."

However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
