If you are not satisfied with the eventual outcome of your request then you are entitled to seek an internal review in accordance with the terms of section 21 of the FOI Act 2014. The internal review will be conducted by an officer of a grade higher than that of the officer who made the initial decision regarding your request. You must submit your request for an internal review within 20 working days from the date of the decision notification.

Furthermore, you are also entitled to seek an internal review if no reply is issued to you by the date specified above. This internal review proceeds on the legal basis that the initial request is considered to be refused once the specified time for responding to it has expired.

In the event that you wish to make an application for an internal review, you may do so by writing to the Freedom of Information Unit, Department of Education & Skills, Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 or by emailing foi@education.gov.ie Under the FOI Act 2014, the fee for internal review is €30.
