I refer to your request for access to information under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2014 which was received by this Department on 4th May, 2017

- 1) The amount of funding the Department of Education and Skills provided to the following schools; Holy Trinity Primary School, Donaghmede, Dublin 13, Scoil Colmcille School, Donaghmede, Dublin 13 and St Kevin's School, Donaghmede, Dublin 13 for capital projects in the years 2014, 2015, 2016 and to-date in 2017*
- 2) Please provide a brief description of each capital project in each of the schools referred above for which funding was approval, and the length of time of each capital project took to complete*
- 3) If any of the schools referred above requested additional funding for capital projects, which has been received by Department, but no decision has been made if that funding is to be approved or refused as of the end of business of Friday 28 April 2017.*

I wish to advise you that I am now providing material to you in respect of (2) and (3) above. My colleague, Ms Yvonne Shanley, will be responding to your request indicated at (1) above.

In May 2015 St Kevin's Primary School was approved funding for Fire Safety Works which was completed in June 2016.

In July 2016 St Kevin's Primary School was approved funding to create two classrooms, which was completed in June 2106.

In May 2014 Holy Trinity Primary School was approved funding to build an ASD unit, which is under construction at the moment.

There is no case to report for question (3) above.

Responsibility for delivering the projects was devolved directly to the Board of Management of each school.
