
Details of all non-personal FOI requests will be recorded on an FOI disclosure log which will be published on the Department of Educations & Skills website in due course.

Rights of Review

In the event that you are not happy with this decision you may seek a review of this decision by writing to the Freedom of Information Unit, Department of Education & Skills, Marlborough Street, Dublin 1 seeking an internal review of the matter and referring to or enclosing a copy of this letter. Please note that a fee applies for such a review. The level of this has been set at €30 and payment should be made by way of bank draft, money order or postal order, and made payable to the accountant in the Department of Education & Skills. Please note the Department of Education & Skills no longer accepts cheque payments from business users. You should submit your appeal within 4 weeks from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding the weekend and public holidays. The making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The review will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body and the decision will be communicated to you within 3 weeks.
