I refer to the request which you made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for records held by this Department:

*'Under the Freedom of Information Act 2014, I  would be grateful if you could provide me with a copy of all correspondence electronic or otherwise between the department of Education and the KWETB relating to the proposed new school building for North Wicklow Educate Together Secondary School (NWETSS) on the Bray Institute of Further Education (BIFE) site, Novara Avenue, Bray, Co Wicklow.'*

I, Sinéad Mc Donnell, HEO, have now made a final decision to grant your request on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

You have sought access to the records by means of scanned copies by Email and I consider this an appropriate form of access in this case. Accordingly, a copy of the records are now attached including a copy of the schedule to these records.

### Right of appeal

Please note the Department of Education and Skills no longer accept cheque

You should make your appeal within 4 weeks from the date of this notification, where a day is defined as a working day excluding, the weekend and public holidays. However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this body.
